



## One-Minute Daily Prayer Kit

*A Simple Way to Pray for People Far from God—one day at a time.*

Each day includes:

- A **Focus Word** (theme or idea)
- A **Short Scripture**
- A **1-2 Sentence Prayer**
- An optional **Prompt** for further prayer or reflection

### Sample Week (7 Days)

#### Day 1 – Dependence

**Scripture:** “Apart from me you can do nothing.” – John 15:5

**Prayer:** Lord, I need You today. Help me depend on You, not myself.

**Prompt:** What part of today do you need God's strength for?

#### Day 2 – Love in Action

**Scripture:** “Let all that you do be done in love.” – 1 Corinthians 16:14

**Prayer:** Jesus, teach me to love others the way You love me.

**Prompt:** Who needs a kind word or act of love from me today?

#### Day 3 – Open Eyes

**Scripture:** “I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest.” – John 4:35

**Prayer:** Lord, help me see the people around me the way You do.

**Prompt:** Who in your life might be more open than they appear?

#### Day 4 – People Far from God

**Scripture:** “My heart’s desire and prayer to God...they may be saved.” – Romans 10:1

**Prayer:** Father, open the heart of someone I care about who doesn’t yet know You.

**Prompt:** Say their name and ask God to draw them closer.

#### Day 5 – Courage

**Scripture:** “Be strong and courageous... for the Lord your God is with you.” – Joshua 1:9

**Prayer:** Lord, give me courage to do what is right, even when it's hard.

**Prompt:** Is there a step of obedience or faith you’re avoiding?

#### Day 6 – Seeds of Truth

**Scripture:** “I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth.” – 1 Corinthians 3:6

**Prayer:** Lord, use even my small words or actions to plant seeds of truth in their heart.

**Prompt:** What small act of kindness or honesty could point to Jesus today?

#### Day 7 – Presence

**Scripture:** “Surely I am with you always, to the end of the age.” – Matthew 28:20

**Prayer:** Jesus, remind me You are with me in every moment today.

**Prompt:** As you walk or drive, say “You are with me” as a breath prayer.
