1. Main Goal

Your testimony isn't just about your story, but about **God's story**. It must include the **Gospel of Jesus**, pointing beyond your life to:

- God's grace
- Jesus as Savior
- The faith that transforms

Your story should help others see **His redemption**, not just your journey.

2. How to Create Your Testimony

- **Keep it short**
- **Before Christ**
→ What was missing? How did sin show up? What were you trusting instead of God?
- **Meeting Christ**
→ When did you realize you needed a Savior? How did you hear the Gospel? How did you respond?
- **After Christ**
→ How has your heart or purpose changed? How are you walking with the Lord now?
- **Make the Gospel clear**
- **Avoid Christian-only language**

3. Sample 2-Min Testimony

"I used to think I was a pretty decent person. I never caused trouble for others and tried to live a responsible life. My goal was simple: to achieve success—the kind of success the world praises—money, influence, status.

But deep down, I was full of pride, fear, and guilt. No matter how hard I worked to reach my goals, I felt empty, like I could never truly become the person I was striving to be.

Then one day, I ran into a friend I hadn't seen in years. He used to live a wild life—drinking, partying—but now he was completely different. He was calm, kind, and genuinely joyful. His words were encouraging, and his attitude was full of peace. I was curious—what changed him?

That's when he shared his story and the good news of Jesus. As I listened, I realized my problem wasn't just on the surface. It went deeper—my life was being shaped by sin. I was living without God at the center.

Then I heard that Jesus came to save sinners like me. He died in my place and rose again to offer forgiveness—not because I earned it, but because of His grace. That day, I put my faith in Him—not in myself or my success.

Now I live with peace and purpose. I still fall short, but I walk with the Lord daily, trusting Him more with each step—even with my business dreams, which are now in His hands.”

4. Tips for Sharing

- Keep it under 2 minutes – attention spans are short!
- Focus on **God**, not yourself
- End with a **simple invitation** to trust Jesus
(e.g., *“What Jesus did for me, He can do for you.”*)
