

Conversation Tips

Simple ways to connect, build trust, and let God lead.

- Be Curious and Listen Well Approach the person with a genuine desire to know them. Curiosity shows care, and attentive listening builds trust. Don't just listen to respond—listen to understand. People feel loved when they feel heard.
- 2. Speak with Love Let your words be kind, gentle, and respectful. Even when you share truth, speak in a way that builds up, not pressures.
- **3. Ask Sincere, Thoughtful Questions** Go beyond surface talk. Ask questions that invite reflection and show genuine interest in their story and beliefs.
- 4. Be Patient—Let Trust Grow Naturally Don't rush the conversation. Let trust develop over time as you walk alongside the person in love and faith.
- 5. Pray as You Go Keep the conversation bathed in prayer. Ask God silently for wisdom, love, and the right words—before, during, and after you speak. Trust that He is already at work in their heart.
