

3 Ones Stories: Sharing & Celebration

*“Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, making the best use of the time. Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person.” **Colossians 4:5–6***

1. Welcome

- “Today is a celebration of what God has been doing through One Prayer, One Conversation, One Story.”
- Open with a short prayer of gratitude

2. Vision Reminder — Brief recap of the **3 Ones**:

- One Prayer — *We align with God’s heart*
- One Conversation — *Listening and connecting naturally*
- One Story — *Sharing how Jesus has been real in your life*

*“Results matter, but they are God’s work. **Our part is obedience** — and that is what we celebrate, because God moves through simple, ordinary steps of faith.”*

3. Share — What Has God Been Doing?

“As you look back on the workshop(s), what stood out to you, and how have you seen God at work through One Prayer, One Conversation, or One Story?”

Where Did You See God at Work?

- Did God open a meaningful or unexpected conversation?
- Did someone express spiritual curiosity or ask a faith-related question?
- Did you sense new courage, compassion, or spiritual awareness growing in your own heart?

These reflections help us recognize God’s quiet, faithful work as we walk with others—one prayer, one conversation, one story at a time.

4. Encouragement from Scripture by Shohei

- *“The one who plants and the one who waters work together, but God makes it grow.”* — 1 Corinthians 3:6–7
 - We plant.
 - We water.
 - **God brings growth.**

5. Gratitude & Prayer

- “Lord, continue to use us. Help us notice, listen, and love the people You put in front of us.”
